## From Patricia's Corner

Have you ever heard someone say that tithing cannot be found in the New Testament as if to infer that God does not expect Christians today to tithe? We must remember that the Bible is not two separate unrelated books. There are hundreds of verses in the Old Testament that are in the New Testament. Many prophecies in the Old Testament are fulfilled in the New Testament. God imbedded the Messiah and his teachings of righteousness throughout both Old and New Testaments.

The first mention of tithing in the Old Testament is Genesis 14:18-24. The context is that Abram had just successfully fought the Battle of Dan and confiscated their goods. Melchizedek, king of Salem and priest blessed Abram. Abram, how knew all of God's statutes, gave Melchizedek tithes of all in thanks to God saying "I lift up mine hand unto the Lord, the most high God, the possessor of heaven and earth." The king of Sodom tried to talk Abram into keeping everything rather than honoring the man of God. Abram refused even the smallest part. Abram blessed God by sowing goods to his priest. And what do you think happened to Abram? God blessed him immeasurably. Abram became rich not because of what he kept but because he gave to the priest. Tithing blesses the giver as well as the receiver.

The next record of tithing is in Numbers 18. The Hebrews were a patriarchal society where the largest unit was the family prior to their exodus from Egypt. Once they left Egypt, they became a nation of people, the Israelites, governed by God's law, the Torah (the first five books of the Bible), and led by their shepherd Moses. God commanded Aaron and his offspring to become the Levitical priesthood with priestly duties. God commanded that they have no inheritance in Israel and no part among them in national settlement and that the tithes of Israel be given to the tribe of Levi for their services. God instituted other tithes, too, totally 30% but we won't talk about them now (check out Numbers chapter 18). God's purpose in tithing was to bless the Israelites. God is getting kind of predictable here, huh?

And there's Deuteronomy chapter 28 which contains twenty-one blessings of obedience and fifteen curses for disobedience. Blessings and curses are examples of the kingdom principle of sowing and reaping. If you sow obedience to God's commandments, you reap blessings. If you sow disobedience, you reap curses. If you sow to the church where you are spiritually fed, you reap growth in the Word, fellowship, opportunities to serve in the kingdom, and so much more.

Galatians 6:6 says "Let him that is taught in the word communicate unto him that teacheth in all good things." The Greek word for communicate is *koinoneo* means to share with, communicate and *distribute* and specifically refers to the material support of the ministry. And it's no coincidence that the next two verses reiterate God's principle of sowing and reaping. "Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption, but he that soweth to the spirit shall of the spirit reap life everlasting." Ministers are the shepherds of our spiritual growth and the church we attend is the storehouse where we are spiritually fed. You might say: well, I'm fed by that evangelist on the TV. God commands that we support our storehouse but after that you can sow seed elsewhere as the Holy Spirit leads.

When Jesus sent forth his twelve disciples to the lost sheep of Israel, he told them "not to acquire gold, or silver, or copper. ... for the worker is worthy of his support" (NASB Matt. 10:9-10). When Jesus ordained, commissioned, and sent forth seventy preachers and healers, he instructed them to get food and drink where offered (Luke 10:7). How shall men of God be supported asks Paul in 1 Cor. 9:13 "Do ye not know that they which minister about holy things live of the things of the temple? And they which wait at the altar are partakers with the altar?" Good question: how else are they supported if not through tithing? Interestingly though, Paul refused it. Neither is our Pastor James taking pay because we are not supporting him.

Melchizedek was a mere type of Christ's eternal priesthood which still exists. God laid down the principle of supporting the ministry in the Old Testament through Abram to Melchisedec. "Jesus is priest forever, after the order of Melchizedek" (Heb 5:6). "Which hope [Jesus] we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast and

which entereth into that without the veil; Whither the forerunner is for us entered, even Jesus, made an high priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek (Heb 6:19-20). Does it make any sense to you that the first priest Melchisedec be the only one that received tithes? Does it make any sense to you that God commanded the Israelites to tithe to the Levitical priesthood and then discontinue it after Christ became the priest after this order? That would be saying that grace lessens the burden and that God changes (NOT!).

It is God's most marvelous plan that we continue in Abraham's faith. It is God's rich teaching that we are to honor Jesus' eternal priesthood by tithing to our church where the Word of God is preached to all and many are saved. It is self evident that without tithing to support our church, the church cannot exist. Without being fed we cannot be the ambassadors for Christ that God commanded us to be. All of the glory and honor go to our amazing Lord God for allowing us to be part of His plan. The alternative theory is that God has left support of God's kingdom after Jesus' death and resurrection up to random feelings of guilt, impulse and sentiment. Have faith in all of God's Word. Tithe. Bless God and be blessed.

## Two Horses

Just up the road from my home is a field, with two horses in it. From a distance, each horse looks like any other horse. But if you stop your car, or are walking by, you will notice something quite amazing... Looking into the eyes of one horse will disclose that he is blind. His owner chose not to have him put down, but has made a good home for him. This alone is amazing.



If you stand nearby and listen, you will hear the sound of a bell. Looking around for the source of the sound, you will see that it comes from the smaller horse in the field. Attached to the horse's halter is a small bell. It lets the blind friend know where the other horse is, so he can follow.

As you stand and watch these two friends, you'll see that the horse with the bell is always checking on the blind horse and that the blind horse will listen for the bell and then slowly walk to where the other horse trusting that he will not be led astray. When the horse with the bell returns to the shelter of the barn each evening, it stops occasionally and looks back. Making sure that the blind friend isn't too far behind to hear the bell.

Like the owners of these two horses, God does not throw us away just because we are not perfect or because we have problems or challenges. He watches over us and even brings others into our lives to help us when we are in need...

Sometimes we are the blind horse being guided by the little ring of bell of those who God places in our lives. Other times we are the guide horse, helping others to find their way.... Be kinder than necessary-- everyone you meet is fighting some kind of battle.
