### THE FRUIT OF RIGHTEOUSNESS

There is a fruit of righteousness. As a new creature, God says that you are to bring forth fruit (or evidence) of your new nature. Your new nature is a love nature with the righteousness of God. II Corinthians 9: 10 tells us, ‘Now he that ministereth seed to the sower both minister bread for your food, and multiply your seed sown, and increase the FRUITS OF YOUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.’

James 3: 18 further states, ‘THE FRUIT OF RIGHTEOUSNESS is sown in peace of them that make peace.’

According to Philippians 1: 11, the new creature is to be ‘... filled with the FRUITS OF RIGHTEOUSNESS, which are filled by Christ Jesus, unto the glory and praise of God.’

When you know you are made righteous, the fruit of righteousness should show forth in your life. You should act righteous and lay hold of everything that is rightfully yours because of your right standing with God.

You are a new creature in Christ Jesus! You are not the kind of person you used to be. II Corinthians 5: 17 reaffirms, ‘Therefore if any person is in Christ, the Messiah, he is a new creature altogether, a new creation, the old (previous moral and spiritual condition) has passed away, Behold the fresh and new has come!’ (Amplified version)

You need to realize your inheritance in Christ.

The greatest problem of man, especially the new creature, has been sin and sin-consciousness.

There has been a lack of ‘righteousness-consciousness’ in the hearts and minds of God’s people.

**THE GREATEST NEED OF THE NEW CREATURE IS TO REALIZE HOW RIGHTEOUS HE IS IN CHRIST AND THEREFORE HOW BOLDLY HE CAN ACT AS A NEW CREATURE IN FACING SATAN AND DEMON FORCES!**

When a man is conscious of his old sinful nature and is not conscious of his true righteous nature in Jesus Christ, he cannot stand confidently in the presence of God. Hebrews 4: 16 says, ‘Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.’ As new creatures we are entitled to come boldly to throne of grace.

A sense of unworthiness, or a sense of condemnation paralyzes the new creature!

Every new creature needs to be free from this type of negativism and condemnation!

No matter how much God has done for you, until you realize that you are free from unrighteousness and you are made righteous in god, you will be paralyzed in your ability to minister to people in need.

AS LONG AS THERE IS A SENSE OF INFERIORITY, THERE CAN BE NO SENSE OF AUTHORITY!!!!

Just think of new creatures who are paralyzed, immobile, and not moving in the flow of God's blessings! The devil has tried to keep millions of Christians in fear and defeat by keeping them ignorant of the truth of their righteousness through Jesus Christ.

Some people say what we Christians need is more power. Others say we need more faith. Well, of course we need these, but what the new creature needs most of all is an understanding of the Word of God.

What you need as a new creature is to understand by the Holy Ghost what God has done for you in Christ.

You need to know you are righteous and without sin in the sight of God! You are totally without condemnation! Romans 8: 1 says, 'There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.'

When you understand this, faith will arise in your spirit just as naturally as breathing!

Power comes to you automatically because of the understanding you gain in knowing you are in right standing with God.

## **A CALL TO BIBLE STUDY**

I am beginning a new series of studies from Ezekiel 34, Daniel and Revelation, on Sunday at 9:00 AM in the Christian Education Building. I have always quoted the following principal "first comes the natural, then comes the Spiritual." Let's compare your physical diet to your spiritual diet. For instance what would happen if you ignore the rumble in your tummy at breakfast, lunch or dinner? Would you begin to feel shaky, light headed and maybe even feel faint? Would your digestive system fail miserably and would your health begin to go downhill? It would follow that your body would lose strength; you would no longer be able to function. In the natural this is what would happen to your physical man if you do not feed your body properly.

Now we know what happens in the natural to your body with no food, now think about your spiritual man. What would happen if you continually ignore feeding your spiritual man? If you do not read Scripture and study the Word of God on a daily basis by tending to your spiritual diet you become a weak, sluggish, a dysfunctional Christian! Worse, you become ineffective in your witness for the Lord. "2 Timothy 2:15, commands us to "Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the Word of truth."

Ezekiel 36:21-23 teaches us that God wants a people who are knowledgeable in the Word. Hansie Steyn Ministries consist of Evangelists Hansie and Jeanette Steyn and their daughter Elizabeth, missionaries / evangelists from South Africa. After receiving a word from the Lord (Gen. 12: 1 - 3...) they became obedient, and finally left their country in 2001, to immigrate to America. Hansie and Jeanette are fulltime missionaries / evangelist since 1996 and are now living in America.



Hansie was born in Springs South Africa, but grew up in Zambia, Africa. He later attended the university of Pretoria (South Africa) where he obtained a B Com. and Honours degree in Business Economics and became a teacher. Hansie got involved in bands and became a full - time " rock - musician " playing in nightclubs and disco's. In 1983 his whole life changed when he became a born again Christian. He then went back to a teaching career, where he met Jeanette. They started a Christian group called " MAJESTY ", got married in 1987, and Hansie became a lecturer at a College and later at a University. It has now been 26 years since his salvation, and his life is a wonderful testimony of the power of Jesus Christ.

Jeanette was born in Pretoria, South Africa, and was privileged to grow up as a minister's child. She also attended the University of Pretoria and obtained a music degree in 1983. She then became a teacher, where she met Hansie. Jeanette has known the Lord ever since she was a child. Being brought up in a Christian home, gave her the sure foundation on which she could build her ministry. She resigned her position as a teacher in 1995, to travel fulltime with her husband.



Hansie and Jeanette have released 5 CD's under the music group name of " MAJESTY " A characteristic of " MAJESTY'S " music is that it appeals to all age groups, young and old. The songs minister in relationships, marriages, the love of Jesus, and include their own praise and worship style. The style of music is contemporary and the lyrics are straight down the line, but very encouraging. All the songs are original, inspired by the Holy Spirit. God has given them a longing and a deep desire to spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ to those who are lost and to encourage the body of Christ. ## Our Hebrew Roots

Part VI

This month we learn about the last fall feast, the Feast of Tabernacles or the Feast of Booths. And to confuse things more, it also has another name, Sukkot. It is described in Leviticus 23:33-43. It is in the 7<sup>th</sup> Jewish calendar month of Tishri, starting on the 15th day and lasting for seven days. It starts five days after Yom Kippur and is a Holy Convocation (dress rehearsal) that is to be kept forever (Lev. 23:41). Before destruction of the first temple in Jerusalem, Jews made a mass pilgrimage to celebrate this feast. All Jewish males were required to go to Jerusalem to appear before the Lord with offerings (Deut. 16:16).

It is a harvest celebration memorializing how the Israelites survived in the wilderness. Remember that the Israelites were led by the prophet Moses out of slavery in Egypt through the desert for 40 years before reaching the Promised Land. God said "You shall live in booths for seven days... So that your generations may know that I had the sons of Israel live in booths when I brought them out of the land of Egypt. I am the Lord your God." (Deut. 23:43)

In Israel today, Jews erect temporary booths for housing and stay in them during this holiday. Many eat their meals in them, too. Sukkot means booth or tabernacle (albeit temporary shelters). Today they are made of wood or wood and canvas. The roof is made of branches and leaves (Lev. 23:40) with openings to see the stars. Today citron, myrtle, palm, and willow are used to make a lulav which is waved in all four directions and up and down to symbolize that God is everywhere. I love that!

Now for the amazing way that God used this festival as a symbolic dress rehearsal to teach them about Jesus (Yeshua). On the last day of this feast people carrying torches marched around the Temple and then set these lights around the walls of the Temple indicating that the Messiah would be the light to the Gentiles (Is. 49:6). In another ceremony a priest carried water from the pool of Siloam to the Temple, symbolizing that when the Messiah comes the whole earth will know God just "as the waters cover the sea" (Is. 11:9). Remember that Jesus attended the feasts and on the last day of this feast he said "If anyone is thirsty, let him come to me and drink. Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, streams of living water will flow from within him (John 7:37-38). While the torches were burning the next morning, he said "I am the light of the world. He that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life." (John 8:12). In the future, this festival will represent when all nations will share in the joy and blessings of God's kingdom. I would call that: literally living in God's presence or - tabernacling with God! Jesus (Yeshua) is coming again to tabernacle among us. Give God all the glory and honor.

*(Giving and Tithing Too Busy To Serve – pp. 12-13)*

**OBSERVATIONS**

Once an understanding of God's promise is reached, it is necessary to believe that promise. I determined to make a study of giving and receiving in the lives of Christians I knew and then match the result of my study to God's Word. Since all of God's principles are given as examples for living, an applied principle must be verified in changed lives. If it isn't, we're probably misunderstanding the principle or else not applying it. Before I define the scriptural principle, I will give some observations of the study that started many years ago and still continues.

1. Most Christians give far less than one-tenth of their income to work done in the Lord's name.
2. Many Christians give at least one tenth of their incomes regularly but do not experience what they assess to be God's material or spiritual bounty.
3. Many Christians give at least a tenth of their incomes and can identify many instances of God's abundance, either materially, spiritually, or both.
4. A small percentage of Christians give far beyond a tenth of their incomes but cannot identify anything they would describe as God's abundant return.
5. A very small percentage of Christians give far beyond a tenth of their incomes and can identify God's response, both generally and specifically.

Of course, there were other categories and instances in which Christians moved from one group to another. Many of those can be explained because of spiritual growth or withdrawal, which obviously affects every area of our lives. A few can be classified as unique from a biblical perspective. That is most clear when a spiritually mature Christian gives in great abundance and outwardly appears to suffer materially. The apostle Paul would most assuredly identify with that group. God has a separate and unique plan for such people, and the depth of their commitment to Christ sets them apart in spiritual blessings. I offer some observations about these groups, with no intent to be judgmental. I believe God has provided us with material indicators of spiritual conditions. They are not for accusation but for admonition.

**DON'T ROB GOD**

Those who give less than a tenth of their income limit what God can do for them according to His own Word. "Will a man rob God? Yet you are robbing Me! But you say, 'How have we robbed Thee?' In tithes and offerings" (Malachi 3:8). Lest we somehow believe that principle applies only to the Old Covenant, Paul amplifies it for us: "Now this I say, he who sows sparingly shall also reap sparingly; and he who sows bountifully shall also reap bountifully." (2 Corinthians 9:6). A lack of giving is an external material indicator that spiritual changes need to be made.

Those who give more than a tenth, but not sacrificially, may experience God's abundance according to His plan for them because they are meeting God's prerequisites for them at that time.

Many who give what we consider a material abundance and do not experience any particular spiritual or material reply may actually be giving for self-motivated reasons. Many people try to bribe God into blessing them. They are like Simon in Acts 8, who when he observed the benefits of God's power tried to acquire it without meeting the spiritual prerequisites. They demand God's blessing to reward what they consider to be their sacrifice. They are not in subjection to God but are trying to exercise control over Him. Paul addressed that attitude also in Romans 11:34-35: "Who has known the mind of the Lord, or who became His counselor? Or who has first given to Him that it might be paid back to him again?"
